PONTOON B AND PONTOON C, SOUTH BANK

City Parklands Services Pty Ltd (City Parklands) manages Pontoon B and Pontoon C.

Conditions of Use

1. Pontoon B and Pontoon C are available to personal leisure craft for a maximum of three (3) hours throughout the day on a first in, first served basis. No bookings are required. Mooring facilities are free for leisure vessels.
2. Operators must ensure that vessels meet the following requirements:
 - a. Pontoon – maximum displacement 30 tonnes.
 - b. Fenders – maximum vessel length – 9metres.
 - c. One vessel per pontoon.
3. **Strictly no commercial vessels permitted unless authorised by City Parklands (South Bank Visitor Information Centre).**

Commercial vessels with a booking and appropriate fee paid have priority. A sign will be placed on the pontoon if it is booked for a commercial vessel.

4. Mooring facilities are not available during major events. The pontoon will be closed, and signage placed out advising of the closure.
5. Use of these mooring facilities is entirely at the risk of the user.
6. City Parklands will not be held liable for any damage to vessels or property incurred whilst mooring at South Bank.
7. Users will be held liable for damage caused by vessels using the mooring facilities.
8. No rubbish to be left on or in the vicinity of the mooring facilities.
9. City Parklands, including its authorised Security Officers reserves the right to move on any vessel.
